The Lake Travis Education Foundation is the largest contributor of non-tax-generated funding to our schools. We need extraordinary directors to work toward increasing our support.


The foundation needs people who have good ideas, can work well in a group decision-making environment, and are willing to personally expend the effort necessary to make sure those ideas come to fruition.

## Become a Director.

### Make a DIRECT impact.

The Lake Travis Education Foundation Board is comprised of a maximum of 33 volunteer directors who serve three-year terms on a rotating basis. New directors are elected annually to fill openings. Candidates are evaluated in light of diversity regarding experience, occupation, interests, school boundaries, and other factors as appropriate.

Serving as a director of the Lake Travis Education Foundation affords you the opportunity to make a significant, direct impact on the education of the children of the Lake Travis Independent School District. Directors may choose to serve on a variety of committees during their term.

**FUNDRAISING** is a prime focus. Annual fundraising events include the “Fore” the Kids Golf Tournament and the Annual Gala. All directors serve on at least one of these fundraising committees, and the entire board participates in carrying out the events.

The **CORPORATE SPONSORSHIP COMMITTEE** works to foster partnerships between LTEF and businesses to secure financial support.

The **SCHOOL COMMUNICATIONS COMMITTEE** is dedicated to raising awareness of LTEF’s mission in the district campuses and beyond.

The **FINANCE COMMITTEE** manages the Foundation’s investments.

Serving on the **GRANT** or **SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEES** allows you to see all the hard work pay off as educators receive funding for their projects, and high school seniors are awarded for their academic excellence.

The **NOMINATING COMMITTEE** is charged with the responsibility of identifying potential directors and their desire to serve. This committee evaluates candidates and prepares a slate for election by the full board of directors.
